The aforementioned claimant registered the aforementioned vehicle with the Department of Transportation of the Government of The United States of America on March 1st, 2016.

Notice of Mode of Registration

The Department of Transportation of the Government of The United States of America accepts registrations of Motor Vehicles under the classification of Territorial Supremacy as declared and published on October 28th, 2015, in the Declaration of Sovereignty, Section IV: Territorial Supremacy, paragraph (A):

The Government has the supremacy over its legal person, its properties, its activities and its capital building. ([link](#))

Notice of Non-consent

Territorial Supremacy as declared and published on October 28th, 2015 in the Declaration of Sovereignty, Section IV: Territorial Supremacy, paragraph (B):



The legal person, properties and activities of the Government within its existing and expanding boundaries are inviolable and cannot be changed, claimed, seized or used without its consent. ([link](#))

Further, the Government of The United States of America (hereinafter "Government") did not consent, neither expressed nor implied, to the seizure of the aforementioned vehicle by the City of Conroe Police Department on or before July 1st, 2017.

Notice of Economic Independence

Economic Independence as declared and published on October 28th, 2015 in the Declaration of Sovereignty, Section V: Economic Independence, paragraph (C):

C) The Government guarantees protection to all forms of ownership, copyright and trademark. ([link](#))

Notice of Political Rights

The Respondents are operating under a 527 constituent political entity known as the U.S. state of Texas, wherein the State of Texas itself does not recognize the U.S. state of Texas as a sovereign State unless the U.S. state of Texas is under the protection of the States of Texas, wherein an International Public Notice of said agreement is published in a newspaper of general circulation.

The North American National Party is a National Political Party that does recognize the Government of The United States of America, its sovereignty and independence.

Private companies cannot claim internal policies and by-laws as State laws and therefore the U.S. state of Texas is notwithstanding to create a license, registration and insurance policy to be imposed on anyone outside of its constituent political entity, just as the Government of The United States of America cannot impose its laws upon the State of Texas under the Law of Nations.

The corporate body known as U.S. state of Texas has imposed its policies and by-laws upon a sovereign country under the cover of the sovereign State of Texas and therefore has caused the State of Texas to commit vile and nefarious acts against the Law of Nations.

This Notice of Claim is hereby served on the respondents and the government of France for the purpose of peaceful settlement of a dispute over property belonging to the Government of The United States of America, that has been, and is being, unlawfully seized by the City of Conroe Police Department and Koenig Auto & Wrecker LLC, located at 14963 Highway 105 west, Montgomery Texas, 77356.



Notice of Intentions

The Government of The United States of America is seeking immediate remedy for this international incident and is prepared to serve its first motion Tuesday, August 8, 2017, allowing for a twenty-four (24) hour response. If a peaceful settlement to this dispute cannot be resolved by Tuesday, August 8, 2017, by 5PM CST, the subject matter of the motion shall include nationalization of all tort-feasors' public properties as well as seeking substantial economic damages. The Government of The United States of America shall not be held legally liable for the contract by and between city of Conroe police department and the Koenig Auto & Wrecker LLC.

Warning: an international judgement against the sureties under international due process cannot be removed until satisfied. All international judgments for damages are converted into a lien after ninety (90) days against tort-feasors and placed on auction.

Notice of Demand

It is hereby demanded by the Government of the United States of America that the Respondents direct the tort-feasors to return the aforementioned property (vehicle) to the possession of Juan Manuel Rueda, trustee, which defines the aforementioned peaceful settlement of disputes. Otherwise, the Notice of Intentions shall be acted upon by the Government of The United States of America.

Instructions

Return vehicle to: c/o 200 Dr. MLK, Jr. Place South, Conroe, Texas 77301; wherein the property (vehicle) will be picked up under international jurisdiction with Trustee instructed to sign an international receipt of Government property.
